Your Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Sun - 8 Nov, CHCH - Singapore

Depart CHCH today arriving in Singapore around 6pm. We will have a transit hotel for the night in Singapore and will depart for India at 0730. Hotel – Singapore Transit



Day 2: Mon 9 Nov, Devi Garh

Depart Singapore for Mumbai and then fly on to Udaipur arriving mid-afternoon. On arrival we are met and transferred to Devi Garh where we stay in the magnificent Devi Garh Palace which was built in the 1760's and sits atop a hill with wondrous views. This beautiful old building has been restored in a modern style and is quite simply, fabulous! Time to settle in and then we enjoy a beautiful Welcome Dinner.

Day 3: Tues 10 Nov, Devi Garh

This morning we enjoy a magnificent Palace tour from the dungeons to the Belfry. The rest of the day is free, perhaps a game of croquet or enjoy the Spa services or perhaps get tempted by the bar with its rare wine and whiskey collection. This would also be the place to indulge your romantic side. Let us know if you would like to book a private romantic dinner on one of the tiny high balconies. Stargazing is a great option this evening after dinner.

Day 4: Wed 11 Nov, Dungapur

This morning we drive to Dungapur where you can simply feast your eyes on your accommodation! Mirrored floors and Art Deco furnishings and architecture abound. The home of the Maharwal borders a lake and a game park renowned for great bird and wildlife. This afternoon we visit the Dungapur Mews, a unique museum of Cars, Cannons and Carriages.

Day 5: Thurs 12 Nov, Dungapur

This morning we are invited by HRM to the Old Palace and enjoy a viewing of some miniature paintings from the Karma Sutra. We also do a jeep tour of the Fort. In the afternoon enjoy the outdoor activities of rowing, biking or walking. Or simply relax in these gorgeous surroundings. Hotel – Udai Bilas Palace

Day 6: Fri 13 Nov, Udaipur

This morning we make our way to the walled 'Blue City' of Udaipur. Make sure you visit the Crystal Gallery, one of the most lustrous attractions of the rare and precious crystal from the royal treasure. This evening we take a boat tour on Lake Pichola and go past the famous 'James Bond - Octopussy' hotel in the midst of the lake. Enjoy the sunset in the most romantic city of Rajasthan.

Day 7: Sat 14 Nov, Udaipur

This morning we have a private visit to the Agricultural University where research is done on crops and dairy farming. This afternoon we have a guided tour of the City Palace (actually 11 Palaces) including the Museum which houses an exceptional Photographic Gallery. The Vintage Car display is worth a look as well as the spectacular garden for the Royal ladies. We also visit the Jagdish Temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Rest of day free – do explore the narrow



lanes and bright stalls. Hotel – Fateh Prakash Palace

Day 8: Sun 15 Nov, Rohet

Today we drive to Rohet and enroute visit the unusual and beautifully carved Ranakpur Jain Temple. Our accommodation is unique! Our host for the evening (and tomorrow) is a celebrated horse breeder who will invite you to enjoy his unique property. His 350-year-old palace has been renovated into a delightful heritage hotel. Hotel – Rohet Garh

Day 9: Mon 16 Nov, Rohet

This morning we enjoy a desert safari in 4X4 vehicles and witness local artisans and craftsman at work – the potter, the weaver, the wood engraver, etc. Rest of the day is free.





Make sure you view the miniature paintings and take a peep in each other's rooms – they are truly magnificent!

Day 10: Tues 17 Nov, Jodhpur

Today we drive to medieval Jodhpur and enroute we visit a 'National Living Treasure' – the Dhurrie Weaver Roopraj Prajpati at Salawas and his village. All the people of the village weave the traditional rugs of the region and Roopraj has revolutionised their way of life by taking their work to the rest of the world. Jodhpur is often called the blue city, so named for the indigo washed houses. This afternoon we visit the Mehrangarh Fort which dates back to 1459 and dominates the city skyline and provides exceptional views. This evening Pink Gins on the Terrace at sundown are highly recommended. Hotel – Umaid Bhawan Palace

Day 11 & 12: Wed 18 & Thurs 19 Nov, Pushkar

This morning we drive to Pushkar and our tour is timed so that you will have 2 days to enjoy the annual Pushkar Camel Fair. This camel and livestock fair is one of the worlds' largest. Unlike our A&P shows there are also many entertaining competitions to watch including the "longest moustache" and the "bridal competition". A complete sensory overload and fabulous photographic opportunity.

Hotel - Anantara Resort

Day 13: Fri 20 Nov, Jaipur

Today we drive to the vibrant 'Pink City' of Jaipur via the Barefoot College and join them for morning tea. This afternoon we visit the famous Jantar Mantar – the observatory. This complex of ancient stone astronomical instruments is a true wonder. We also see the elaborate façade of the Palace of Winds. Later we explore the fascinating City Palace with its collections of rare manuscripts, paintings, old carpets, armoury and embroidered clothes.

Day 14: Sat 21 Nov, Jaipur

This morning we take traditional and very colourful transport, an elephant ride, to the Amber Fort.

Enjoy a guided tour of this Fort that is an engineering marvel – it is huge! Afternoon at leisure where you can enjoy some fabulous shopping and wander the labyrinth of narrow lanes.

Day 15: Sun 22 Nov, Drive to Ranthambore

This afternoon we drive to Ranthambore National Park and check into our luxurious tented camp.
