## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **Responsibility**

*Adventure Travel* is responsible for making arrangements specified in the itinerary, including transportation, sightseeing and accommodation mentioned. We include the services of independent contractors such as airlines, hotels, & Safari operators, guides & drivers plus other operators whose staff are not agents, employees or servants of *Adventure Travel*. Although we make every effort to ensure that your tour is a great success, we cannot take responsibility for the conduct, nor be held responsible for the actions of people or agents that are not employees of *Adventure Travel*. The international carriage of passengers is subject to international conventions and treaties where applicable. If after your departure, the services included in the tour cannot be supplied or there are changes in an itinerary for reasons beyond our control, *Adventure Travel* will arrange for a provision of comparable services. Any resulting additional expenses will be payable by travellers and any resultant savings will be refunded to holiday participants on their return to New Zealand.

### **Validity**

The prices listed are based on the exchange rates current at the time of pricing. *Adventure Travel* reserves the right to alter these accordingly. Prices are based on a minimum group size of 16 people and a maximum of 20 people. Should the group size be less than 16, a small group surcharge will be applied. Pricing is also based on an exchange rate of USD\$1 = \$NZD0.75 and we reserve the right to apply a currency surcharge should the NZ Dollar weaken against the US dollar before final payment is due.

### **Payment**

Please pay your non-refundable deposit (NZD\$2500) per person upon booking and completing the form. Full payment will be due no later than 15 March 2013. The price quoted is for payment by cash, cheque or direct bank transfer. Cheques: Should be made payable to '*Adventure Travel*'. Our postal address is PO Box 2477, Christchurch. ### **Price**

The price is NZD\$15,995 per person based on twin share.

**Single Supplement** - For those travellers wanting their own room, the tour price is NZD\$18,995.

**Land Only** - The land only cost (excluding flights) is NZ\$13,217 per person twin-share. We will be happy to provide alternative flight and travel options.

### **Comprehensive travel insurance:**

You must have comprehensive travel insurance to travel with us. Please ask your *Adventure Travel* consultant for details of our Premier policy with Mondial Assistance. We recommend taking our travel insurance at the time of paying your non-refundable deposit so you are covered in the event of needing to cancel for an unforeseen reason.

### **Passport and Visa Requirements**

It is important that we sight your passport at the time of booking to confirm we have the correct name for your booking and that your passport is valid and in good order. Airline tickets must be issued in the same surname (family name) and first name as detailed in your passport. Prior to confirming your travel arrangements, you should check your Passport and establish that it will remain current for the entire period of your travel. Most countries require that your Passport remains valid for a period of up to six months after the date upon which you are scheduled to leave such country. If your Passport expires less than six months after the date you are scheduled to leave such country you may be denied entry to that country.

It is necessary to ensure you hold the correct visa/passport requirements for the regions you are travelling to. At present, New Zealanders can either obtain visas for Kenya and Tanzania on arrival or through those countries' Embassies in Australia in advance.

### **Vaccinations**

Certain countries require that travellers be vaccinated against specific diseases. Check with your doctor and the Embassies of countries to which you are to travel to satisfy yourself as to whether your destination has any requirements in this respect. Recommended protection may include Cholera, Typhoid, Meningitis, Hepatitis, Tetanus, Polio and Malaria. Yellow Fever is imperative for entry into Tanzania; a vaccination certificate must be presented on arrival.

### **Cancellation by the traveller**

Should you wish to cancel your participation in this tour, the date of the trip cancellation is the date on which the written cancellation is received by *Adventure Travel*. Our terms are as follows:

- 60 days prior to trip departure – loss of deposit
- Between 30 and 50 days prior to trip departure – 50% of total booking cost
- Less than 30 days prior to departure trip – 100% of total booking cost
